WISDOM

"Wisdom is the right use of knowledge. To know is not to be wise. Many men know a great deal, and are all the greater fools for it. There is no fool so great a fool as a knowing fool. But to know how to use knowledge is to have wisdom." Charles Spurgeon
The word "wisdom" appears in the Bible over times.
Proverbs 9.10: The of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and knowledge of the Holy One is insight.
A precondition to being wise is having a reverence for God as all powerful, all knowing, and all loving.
James 3.13-17:13 Who is wise and understanding among you? By his good conduct let him show his works in the meekness of wisdom. 14 But if you have bitter jealousy and selfish ambition in your hearts, do not boast and be false to the truth. 15 This is not the wisdom that comes down from above, but is earthly, unspiritual, demonic. 16 For where jealousy and selfish ambition exist, there will be disorder and every vile practice. 17 But the wisdom from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, open to reason, full of mercy and good fruits, impartial and sincere.
WISDOM FROM BELOW
People can be very smart, incredibly knowledgeable, come from great families, have lots of fancy degrees, but still be flat out dumb.
Two Marks of Worldly Wisdom:
First: Bitter
Jealousy is that feeling that someone else has something that you should have. It's a natural human emotion that stems from our inbred sin nature. That's why it's the 10 th commandment: You shall not covet. Coveting is looking out at someone else's stuff and thinking it should be yours.
Jealousy, a marker of false wisdom, ultimately stems from
Margaret Thatcher: "The problem with socialism is that you eventually run out of other people's money."

Second: Selfish
Christians should be the best leaders, bosses, accountants, teachers, doctors, architects, construction workers, and salesmen in the world. Why? Because we know based on Colossians 3:23 that we work for the Lord.
Selfish ambition says it's all about Kingdom; Selfless ambition says it's all about Kingdom.
Why do you work hard? What is your ultimate goal? This will reveal the motivation behind your ambition.
Philippians 2.3-4: Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves. Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others.
James says the consequences of wisdom from below are great: Disorder and every vile practice. So Christians should listen up, look different, act different, lead different for the sake of God's Kingdom.

If being worldly wise is book smarts, this is street smarts.
Just as true faith is proven by how you act, James argues that true wisdom is shown not by what you say, but how you live.
